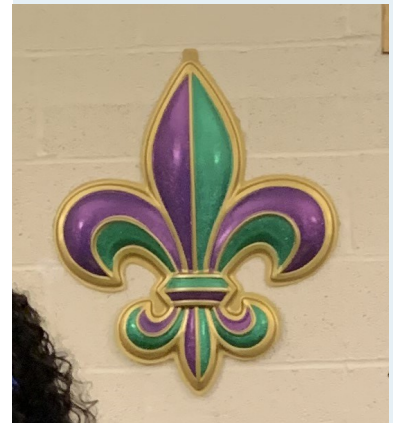
Mardi Gras Celebration
